

Internal Regulations 2026

I. General conditions

Conditions of admission and stay

To be allowed to enter, settle or stay on a campsite, you must have been authorized by the manager or his representative. The latter is required to ensure the proper maintenance and good order of the campsite as well as compliance with these internal regulations.

Staying on the campsite implies acceptance of the provisions of these regulations, the wearing of a bracelet given at reception and the General Terms and Conditions of Sale, as well as an undertaking to comply with them.

No one may take up residence there.

Police formalities

Minors not accompanied by their parents or legal guardians are not allowed on the site.

Pursuant to Article R. 611-35 of the Code on the Entry and Residence of Foreigners and the Right of Asylum, and in order to meet the obligations related to the Environmental Code R125-15 to R125-22, the manager is required to complete and maintain an individual police form. It must mention in particular:

- ✓ The first and last names
- ✓ Date and place of birth
- ✓ Nationality
- ✓ Usual place of residence
- ✓ The email address
- ✓ The mobile phone number
- ✓ The registration plate of the vehicle(s)

(Children under 15 years of age may be listed on the card of one of the parents.)

Installation

The outdoor accommodation and related equipment must be installed at the indicated location in accordance with the guidelines given by the manager or his representative.

Reception desk

Open from Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 17:00 when the campsite is closed

Open from Monday to Sunday from 09:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 18:00 when the campsite is open.

At the reception desk you will find all information about the services of the campsite, information on refueling possibilities, sports facilities, tourist attractions in the area and various addresses that may be useful.

A system for collecting and processing complaints is available to customers.

Viewing

These rules are posted at the entrance of the campsite and at the reception desk. It is given to each customer who requests it and available on the online booking module.

For classified campsites, the classification category with the mention tourism or leisure and the number of tourist or leisure pitches are displayed.

The prices of the various services are communicated to customers under the conditions set by order of the minister in charge of consumption and available for consultation at reception.

Departure arrangements

Customers are invited to inform the reception desk of their departure as soon as possible before it. Guests intending to leave before the opening time of the reception desk must make their payment for their stay on the previous day, as the gate is closed from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am.

Noise and silence

Customers are asked to avoid any noise and discussions that could disturb their neighbours. Sound devices must be adjusted accordingly. Door and trunk locks must be as discreet as possible. Dogs and other animals must never be left at large. They must not be left at the campsite, even locked up, in the absence of their owners, who are civilly responsible for them. The manager ensures peace of mind for his clients by setting times during which silence must be total, from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am.

Visitors

After being authorized by the manager or his representative, visitors may be admitted to the campground under the responsibility of the campers who receive them. The client can receive one or more visitors at reception. The services and facilities of the campsite are accessible to visitors. However, the use of this equipment is subject to a fee (€6.00 per day and per person over 10 years old) Visitors' cars are prohibited in the campsite.

Traffic and parking of vehicles

Inside the campsite, vehicles must drive at a limited speed. Traffic is allowed from 07:00 to 23:00. Only vehicles belonging to the campers staying at the campsite may be driven through the campsite. Parking is strictly prohibited on the pitches usually occupied by accommodation unless a parking space has been provided for this purpose and is prohibited on so-called "Nature" pitches. Parking must not obstruct traffic or prevent the installation of new arrivals.

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Layout and appearance of the facilities

- ✓ Everyone is required to refrain from any action that could harm the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance
- ✓ of the campsite and its facilities, including sanitation.
- ✓ It is forbidden to throw wastewater on the ground or in gutters.
- ✓ Customers must empty the wastewater in the facilities provided for this purpose.
- ✓ Household waste, waste of all kinds, and paper, must be placed in the garbage bin located outside the campsite.
- ✓ Washing is strictly prohibited outside the bins provided for this purpose.
- ✓ The drying of linen will be done, if necessary, in the common dryer. However, it is tolerated near the accommodation, provided that it is discreet and does not interfere with the neighbours. It should never be made from the trees but on the provided clothes racks.
- ✓ Planting and floral decorations must be respected. It is forbidden to plant nails in trees, cut branches, or plant plants.
- ✓ It is not permitted to mark the location of a facility by personal means, nor to dig the ground.
- ✓ Any repair of damage to vegetation, fences, land or campsite facilities will be the responsibility of its author.
- ✓ The pitch that has been used during the stay must be maintained in the state in which the camper found it when he entered the premises.

Security

✓ Fire

Open fires (wood, coal, etc.) are strictly prohibited. Stoves must be kept in good working condition and not used under hazardous conditions. A barbecue area is freely accessible.

In case of fire, notify management immediately. The extinguishers are usable if necessary.

A first aid kit is available at the reception desk.

✓ Theft

The management is responsible for the objects deposited in the office and has a general obligation to monitor the campsite. The camper remains responsible for their own installation and must report to the manager the presence of any suspicious person. Customers are invited to take the usual precautions for backing up their equipment outside the reception office.

Games

No violent or disturbing games may be organised near the facilities.

Children must always be under the supervision of their parents.

Aquatic area

The wearing of clothing not exclusively reserved for swimming is prohibited for hygiene reasons. Only swimsuits designed for swimming are allowed. Swim briefs, boxers, and one-piece swimwear are therefore permitted. Shorts, Bermudas, underpants, loose clothing are therefore prohibited.

Giant buoys, ball games, races and other behaviours aimed at endangering or causing nuisance are strictly prohibited

« Dead garage »

Unoccupied equipment may be left on the ground only after approval from management and only at the indicated location. This service can be paid for.

Violation of the internal regulations

In the event that a resident disrupts the stay of other users or does not comply with the provisions of these internal regulations or the General Terms and Conditions of Sale, the manager or his representative may orally or in writing, if he deems it necessary, to order the latter to cease the disturbances.

In the event of a serious or repeated breach of the internal regulations and after formal notice from the manager to comply with them, the latter may terminate the contract.

In the event of a criminal offence, the manager may call on law enforcement.
